Activity 3: Human Library - Voices of the war on Ukraine


A night of shared experiences, a safe space for everyone to share their voices. Everyone was invited to share how the war is affecting them, or listen and “borrow human beings serving as open books”.






Activity 9: Human Chain Estonia - Solidarity to Ukraine and Iran

At the end of November, JEF Finland's board will come to Tallinn for a knowledge transfer workshop. We have organised for them a sauna debate, and an educational and social programme.


Our scope is to strengthen the link between the 2 chapters.
