
How to get to Madrid by public transport

The airport is **well-connected by both metro and train**. Metro **line 8** (pink) connects Nuevos Ministerios station, in the heart of Madrid, with all the terminals of the airport in just 15 minutes. Alternatively, The **C-1 train line** connects the main train stations with terminal 4 (free shuttle bus connects all terminals). Cost 4,5 € / 3,20 €.





