



Monitoring Committee Sections Update

Context

- In Autumn 2020, we launched a monitoring procedure for Moldova, Montenegro, and Hungary for the same reason, non-payment of membership fees over successive years, and no sign of life.
- Current members of the monitoring committee are Christelle Savall (EB), Aleksandra Aleksejeva (FC), Chris Powers, former EB member, and Tosia Stepniak, former national delegate of JEF Poland.
- **We recommend to expel the sections of Moldova, Montenegro and Hungary at the next Congress, unless there is a change of situation.**



Hungary

- Hungary has not paid its membership fees for a long time but previous EBs have not proposed expulsion because there's an understanding that with the current regime in Hungary, it would be hard to legally register JEF.
- Leonie (contact person in the past mandate) discovered that Balázs Brandt was working to revive JEF Hungary. Please follow their [Facebook](#) and [Instagram](#) accounts!
- There have been difficulties in requesting the transfer of the legal registration of JEF Hungary to Balázs, and so expulsion was requested at the Autumn FC 2020 to provide a document with legal force to support the deletion or (preferably) the transfer of the legal registration. A formal expulsion letter was sent in 2021.
- The group led by Balázs became a candidate section at the incoming FC during the Congress 2021, had their first general assembly and started a legal registration (ongoing).

Montenegro



- Montenegro has not been paying membership fees, there has been no sign of life.
- A formal expulsion letter was sent in 2021.
- Robin, EB contact person for Montenegro, has not yet identified contacts previously in JEF Montenegro.
- A few people are interested in recreating JEF Montenegro and Robin is helping there start their work. If anybody has connections or contacts in Montenegro now, please make introductions!
- **Procedure continues (expulsion potentially at next Congress)**



Moldova



- Moldova has not been paying membership fees, there has been no sign of life. A formal expulsion letter was sent in 2021.
- Juuso (contact person) launched a new call for volunteers in Moldova with the help of Flavia, with a first online meeting with the goal of recreating a section in the country.
- The new group had its first general assembly and elected Eugen Povorozniuc as President, please follow their [Instagram!](#)
- **Procedure continues (expulsion at next Congress), as the registration will not be transferred, due to administrative problems it would create to the new group, which will apply for candidate status at this Federal Committee.**



Poland



- New local section in Łódź and possibly in Kraków .
- Local event in Łódź.
- There is still no established democratic mechanism in the section given the very low amount of members. Reorganising that and increasing the number of active member need to be the priority in the next future.
- **Procedure continues to monitor the process and to support a smooth relaunch of the section.**
