Transportation – How to get to us and around



- Very well connected international airport
 - Direct flights to European cities like Paris, Rome or Madrid
 - A lot of carriers (Lufthansa, Ryanair, Easyjet,...)
- Central train station
 - Direct trains to many popular destinations (Vienna, Venice, Zurich)
 - Most cities can be reached within 3-5 hours
- Top-notch local transportation system
 - Extensive network of metro, busses and trams
 - Easy to get around for attendees

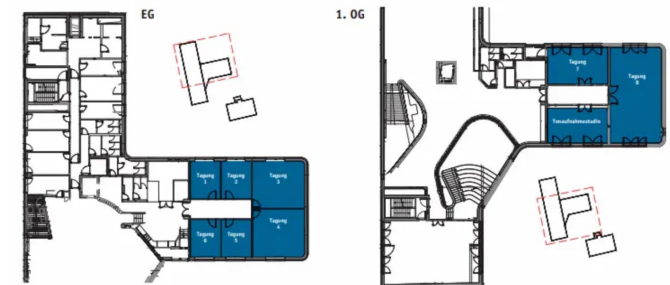


Venues – Option 1: Youth Hostel Munich City



- Located in the West of Munich
 - 15 min metro ride from central train station
 - 1 h metro ride from airport
- 6 separate rooms → can be merged into one large room
- Can be the venue and the accommodation
- Including coffee breaks and lunch
- Beamer, flipchart etc. available

Rent 799 € per day

Venues – Option 2: Scholastika



- Located in the centre of Munich
 - 5 min metro ride from central train station
 - 40 min metro ride from airport
- Very fancy location and often used for concerts
- Several rooms available in different sizes
- Small room offers space for up to 100 people
- Seating and technical features available

Rent 1.100 € per day / 800 € half-day

Venues – Option 3: Flemings Hotel Munich



- Located in the northern part of Munich (“Schwabing”)
 - 20 min metro ride from central train station
 - 1 h metro ride from airport
- Located next to party area “Münchner Freiheit”
- Can be the venue and the accommodation
- Small room offers space for up to 100 people
- Coffee breaks, seating and technical features available

Rent 2.600 € per day

Accommodations – Option 1: Youth Hostel City



- Located in the West of Munich
 - 15 min metro ride from central train station
 - 1 h metro ride from airport
- Oldest youth hostel in Germany
- Can be the venue and the accommodation
- Lunch and dinner can be included
- Beamer, flipchart etc. available

Total: 5.633 € for 95 people (incl. lunch and dinner)

Accommodations – Option 2: Flemings Hotel



- Located in the northern part of Munich (“Schwabing”)
 - 20 min metro ride from central train station
 - 1 h metro ride from airport
- Located next to party area “Münchner Freiheit”
- Can be the venue and the accommodation
- Two people sharing one bedroom



Total: 10.375 € for 95 people

Accommodations – Option 3: a&o Hostel Hackerbrücke



- Located in the centre of Munich
 - 2 min S-train ride from central train station
 - 50 min metro ride from airport
- Several room options (3-6 people in one room)
- Breakfast included
- Maybe cheaper depending on the rooms



Total: 6.530 € for 95 people
