

Travel Information for JEF Europe's Federal Committee in Tartu

1. Arriving at Tallinn Airport:

- **Option 1: Bus from Tallinn Airport**

- Upon arriving at Tallinn Airport, participants can take a bus conveniently located just outside the airport. <https://www.tpilet.ee/en/>
- For more comfort and options, participants can consider using LUX Express for bus services. Visit <https://luxexpress.eu/en/> for schedules and bookings.

- **Option 2: Tallinn Airport + Elron Trains**

- Another option is to take Elron trains from Tallinn to Tartu. There is a train stop near the airport called [Ülemiste](#). This is a short 17 min walk/5 min drive away. The participants can order a taxi using the apps Bolt or Forus (approx. cost 2-3 euro).

2. Arriving from Riga Airport:

- Participants flying into Riga can take a bus to Tartu. Lux Express and Ecolines are popular bus services connecting Riga and Tartu. Check their schedules and book tickets accordingly. If the participants cannot find a suitable time, the schedules from Riga bus station to Tartu bus station can also check. However, participants should consider the distance between Riga airport and Riga bus station that is around 20-25 minutes by taxi (with traffic jam can be more).

3. Arriving from Helsinki Airport:

- For participants flying into Helsinki, Finland, the journey to Tartu can be made via ferry.
 - Take a ferry from Helsinki to Tallinn and follow the aforementioned options from Tallinn to Tartu. The time of the journey from Helsinki port to Tallinn port is around 2 hours. Boarding for ferries closes 30 mins before departure.

4. Arriving from East/Central/West Europe:

- **Flixbus Services:**

- Participants from various parts of Europe, including East, Central, and West, can consider using Flixbus services. However, it could be noticed that a change in Warsaw is needed and the trip from Warsaw to Tallinn is around 17-18 hours.
