HOW TO GET TO THE ACCOMMODATION FROM TALLINN AIRPORT

Option 1: Bus from Tallinn Airport to Tartu Bus Station


Upon arriving at Tallinn Airport, participants can take a bus conveniently located just outside the airport. <https://www.tpilet.ee/en/>
For more comfort and options, participants can consider using LUX Express for bus services. Visit <https://luxexpress.eu/en/> for schedules and bookings.

Tartu Stations to Hostels

To reach the hostels from the Tartu bus station or train station, participants have two options. They can either take a cab using Bolt or Forus taxi, or opt for a local bus. A 1-hour ticket for the bus costs approximately €1.5-2 euros and can be purchased directly from the bus using contactless payment.

Option 2: Elron Trains to Tartu Train Station

Near the airport, there's a train stop called Ülemiste, just a 17-minute walk away. Participants can order a taxi using the Bolt or Forus taxi apps to reach the train stop (approximately costing 2-3 euros). For train schedules and bookings, they can visit <https://elron.ee/>.



HOW TO GET TO THE ACCOMMODATION FROM TARTU AIRPORT


From Tartu International Airport by Bus

The journey from the Tartu Airport to the Hostels normally takes around 30-45 minutes.

Google maps will recommend the best bus route option for your arrival time.

The fare for a 1.5 hour bus ticket is €1.5-2 euros or for the express airport shuttle is €5.

Tickets can be purchased from the bus driver using a contactless payment bank card.



From Tartu International Airport by Cab

Participants have the option to take a cab from the Airport to the Hostels. Tartu offers several apps that you can download to avoid the typically higher fees associated with Airport Taxis. Bolt and Forus Taxi are the two main ride-hailing services in Tartu.
