

Experts meeting “Next Chapter Europe - Youth voice on the Conference on the Future of Europe ”

Call for trainers

Young European Federalists (JEF Europe) is looking for **2 trainers** to facilitate an online meeting of experts between 29.3.-1.4. The expert meeting will consist of 4 three hour sessions between 16:00-19:00. As an outcome, it is expected to have a clear overview how to outline a good local consultation on the CoFoE and know how to creatively engage young people. The expert meeting will consist of a three-day part with experts for activities, local consultations (29.3.-31.3.2021) and a one-day session with experts on visual, artistic work and accessible exhibitions (1.4.2021)

About the project

The project Next Chapter Europe - Youth Voice on the Conference for the Future of Europe aims at bringing the Conference on the Future of Europe (CoFoE) close to the young people at the local level through an informative pan-European campaign and discussion workshops. This will include the creation of an exhibition on Europe’s past and future, to be presented on the European Youth event. Participants of the project will be able to talk confidently about the CoFoE and actively express their opinions, this will also be essential during the local consultation of young people.

About the event

The event is one of the activities during the project “Next Chapter Europe”. It will take place online and will gather 10 to 15 Experts from the civic and public sector. The specific objectives are answering the following questions:

Expert group 1: Activities and youth participation

- What would be an efficient format for local consultations that would attract young people? What needs to be taken care of to successfully organise a consultation?
- How can we present the CoFoE in an easy-accessible way to young people and engage them into the discussion?

Expert group 2: Artistic presentation of European past and future

- What do we have to think of when creating an exhibition for everyone, how can we make it attractive? What creative tools can we need?
- How can we use the outcomes of citizen consultations in a creative way?

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Tasks and responsibilities of the facilitators

- Cooperate with the event organizers and project coordinators and have regular communication with them, including a 2 hour preparatory meeting
- Develop and prepare the overall program and working methodology.
- Prepare session outlines for each of the online sessions
- Facilitate the sessions and provide a suitable environment for interaction to all experts
- Have daily evaluations with the project coordinator and the facilitators' team during the event and a final evaluation after the event.
- Give feedback to outlined sessions and artistic ideas
- Prepare a final report 2 weeks after the training at the latest.

Requirements

- Basic knowledge on the policies connected to the Conference on the Future of Europe
- Working experience in the intercultural education field
- Experience in developing sessions
- Previous experience in organising expert meetings
- Sticking to deadlines and formal requirements
- Sensitivity to diversity
- Proficient user of English language, both in written and spoken English.

Finances

- 300 € per facilitator for subsistence cost (food, coffee, materials) during the whole event
