## Important to Note:

- ✿ On the 18th there will be a marathon happening in Belgrade so some public transport may be changed; public transport schedule for this day will be delivered later on.
- ✿ All public transport is free (buses, trams, trolleys), except for the following buses (A1, E2, E6, E9): the most important line : A1 (route from and to the Airport) the ticket is 400rsd, you can only pay in dinars and you buy the ticket with the driver.
- ✿ Avoid getting into unmarked taxis (meaning those that do not have TX at the licence plate and do not have a clear marking of a taxi cab), do not accept any offers for rides at the airport!
- ✿ Please keep in mind that Serbian public transport is sometimes kinda unpredictable, so we urge you to still check all the routes by yourself and not to rely solely on this document, also if you are unsure of something feel free to ask someone younger for help
- ✿ 1 Euro is roughly 120 dinars (117 rsd)



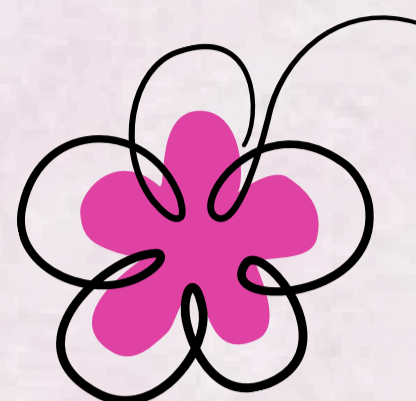

**From the airport to the Chillton hostel:** from the station **Aerodrom Nikola Tesla - dolasci** (2303) take A1 (ticket is 400 rsd) and exit at the station **Fontana** (456) where you will then wait for the bus 65 and then you will exit at the station **Masinskifakultet** (85) and walk to the hostel



**Or another route:** station **Aerodrom Nikola Tesla - dolasci** (2303) take A1 (ticket is 400 rsd) and exit at the station **Savski trg** (1218), move to the station **Savski trg** (70) (this station is right across, in the middle of the street), where you will then wait for the tram 2L and then you will exit at the station **Pravni fakultet** (66) and walk to the hostel (picture below)
